
**S - Senior Review before midday** 


A - All - an Expected Discharge Date (EDD) and Clinical Criteria for Discharge (CCD)

- Multidisciplinary engagement is key to success.

#### What has it achieved?

- Patients are discharged earlier in the day
- Improved team working and communication in the ward and with other wards and Trust staff
- Shift Lead facilitating flow of patients and operational running of the ward
- Improved flow within the hospital
- Increased staff knowledge in Quality Improvement.
