

# YOU KNOW YOUR CHILD BEST...



## 1 Help us to get to know your child better...

Tell us everything about them that might help us understand them more.

## 2 Speak up and speak out

Don't be shy, don't doubt yourself, ask questions.

## 3 Get to know us

Excuse me; I have a few questions before you start, would you mind...

## 4 Clean Hands – everyone everywhere

## 5 Stay Clean & Dry

Catheters, drips, drains, wounds - tell us if the site gets wet or looks worse than before.

## 6 Red or irritated skin

Tell us if you notice changes.

## 7 Know your child's medication

Regular medication – know the name & dosage.

Excuse me, I don't recognise that medication, can you please double check if it is on the chart...

## 8 Be practical on the ward

- Keep Bedrails up
- ID bracelet on
- No hot liquids at the bedside

## 9 Slips, Trips and Falls – Reduce the risk

Ensure your child is well supervised.

What should I look out for at home? Who should I call if I have a problem? Do I need a review anywhere?

## 10 Be prepared when going home
